Confirmation of the Minutes

Confirmation of the Minutes (Second Meeting by Circulation) dated 7th October, 2020 pertaining to preparation of the Panel of Subject Experts of Law.

(Matters related to academic functioning and standards)

Agenda No.1	To Consider the List of Professors of Law for shortlisting/approval on behalf of the university, to be sent to RPSC for Finalization of Panel of Experts in Law.
Brief facts and background	<p>The Board of Management in its first meeting held on 12.09.2020 considered the academic perspective of the University and resolved as under:-</p> <p>“The Board considered and resolved that the academic session 2020-21 may be commenced with LLM (one year/two semesters) with the intake of 40 students. However, due to prevailing circumstances of Covid-19, the admission for this year may be done on the basis of merit of the students in qualifying examination i.e. LLB (three years/five years). A committee of two/three academicians may be constituted by the Vice Chancellor to devise the modalities, structuring of the programme and action plan, keeping in view UGC guidelines about one year LLM degree programme. The reservation policy of the State may be followed for admission. Further, the Vice Chancellor is authorized to take all necessary action/decision for commencement of the programme.”</p> <p>In furtherance of implementation of the aforesaid decision taken by the Board and in order to meet the Academic requirements, the Board further considered the matter pertaining to procedure for preparation of panel of subject experts for selection committee (by circulation through email dated 07.10.2020) and decided as under:-</p>

“The University shall prepare a list of Professors of law, as subject experts for consideration by the Board of Management, which will then shortlist/approve those names on behalf of the University. The names approved by the BoM will then be sent to Rajasthan Public Service Commission (RPSC) for finalization of the panel of subject experts in law for the University. The duly approved panel of experts finalized by RPSC will then be used for selection committees of the University, for selection of faculty in law.”

Accordingly in compliance of the aforesaid decision taken by BoM from time to time, the University has prepared a list of professors of Law, which is as under:

Accordingly, the aforesaid list of professors of law, as subject experts is submitted for consideration and approval by the Board of Management.

Agenda No.2

To consider that the Government may be requested to make required nominations for the Selection Committee of the University.

Brief facts and background

Section 29(1) of Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University, Jaipur Act, 2019 provides as under:-

“29 (1) The Appointment of teacher and officers of the University shall be made in accordance with provision of the Rajasthan Universities, Teachers and Officers (Selection for Appointment) Act, 1974 (Act No.18 of 1974).”

It is submitted that the Rajasthan University teachers and officers (Selection for Appointment) Act No.18 of 1974 provides the following Three or, as the case may be, two experts to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor of the University concerned for the selection of the teachers specified at serial numbers 1,2 and 3 in column 1 of the Schedule shall be chosen by him on the advice of a Committee consisting of a member of Rajasthan Public Service Commission to be nominated by the State Government after consultation with the Chairman of the said Commission who will be the Chairman of the Committee, eminent educationist nominated under clause (iii) of sub-section (1) of Section 5 and the members of the Syndicate nominated under clause (iv) of the said sub-section of the said section and said committee shall from out of the panel of names recommended by the Academic Council recommend to the Vice-Chancellor of the University concerned names of at least twelve experts for each Selection Committee which shall be in order of priority.”

Accordingly, a request may be made to the Government for nomination of an eminent educationist by the State Government for a period of one year as suggested under clause (iii) of sub- section (1) of section 5 and similarly one nomination may also be made by the Government from the BoM under clause (iv) of sub- section (1) of section 5 for a period of one year.

	It is pertinent to mention here that the above nominees will be required for finalization of Panel of Subject Experts for the university by RPSC as well.
Agenda No.3	To consider the process of Affiliation of all the Law Colleges of Rajasthan except constituent colleges of other universities, for the Academic Session 2020-21.
Brief facts and background	<p>Section 4 of Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University, Jaipur Act 2019 provides for the jurisdiction of the University in the following terms:-</p> <p>“4. Jurisdiction.- (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in any law for the time being in force, the jurisdiction of the University shall extend to whole of the State of Rajasthan and all Law colleges, except constituent colleges of other Universities, shall be affiliated to the Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University, Jaipur in accordance with the Statutes, Ordinances and Regulations made under this Act.</p> <p>(2) The State Government may, by order in writing-</p> <p>(a) require any institute, institution or college within the territorial limits of the University to terminate, with effect from such date as may be specified in the order, its association with, or its admission to the privileges of any other University incorporated by law to such extent as may be considered necessary and proper, or</p> <p>(b) exclude, to such extent as may be considered necessary and proper, from association with, or from admission to the privileges of the University constituted by this Act any institute, institution or college specified in the order which, in the opinion of the State Government, is required to be self-governing or to be associated with or admitted to the privileges of, any other University or body.</p> <p>(3) The State Government may, in consultation with the University, by notification published in the Official Gazette, enumerate any Government College situated in the jurisdiction of the University to be a constituent college of the University. All the movable and immovable properties of such colleges shall then vest in the University and the officers, teachers and employees of such colleges, after being found suitable through screening and on fulfilling such terms and conditions as may be laid down in the notification, shall be deemed to be the officers, teachers or, as the case may be, employees of the University.”</p> <p>Subsequently, Secretary, Higher Education, Government of Rajasthan issued an office order dated 22.07.2020 under Section 4(1) & (2) of the aforesaid</p>

Act, whereby it was ordered that all Law colleges situated in the State, except constituent colleges of other universities, shall be run with the affiliation of Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University, Jaipur. It was also ordered that students taking admission in the first year of Undergraduate & Postgraduate Law courses (2020-21) shall be enrolled with Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University, Jaipur. A copy of letter is attached as Annexure-I.

(Annexure-I)

In view of the aforesaid order dated 22.07.2020 of the State Government, the Vice-Chancellor of Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University vide his letter dated 27.07.2020 informed and requested the Vice-Chancellors of all universities situated in the State of Rajasthan as follows-

“As you are aware in order to maintain the standards of legal education in the State of Rajasthan and provide uniformity in academic process of legal education in the state, the Government of Rajasthan has enacted Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University, Jaipur Act No. 6 of 2019, providing for establishment of Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University, Jaipur. In this regard, I would like to draw your kind attention to the order no. 15 (5) education-4/2020 dated 22nd July, 2020 (copy enclosed) of the Government of Rajasthan through which it has been notified that after coming into existence of Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University, Jaipur and in view of the provision contained in section 4(2) (a) (b) of the Act of the University, all the Law Colleges, affiliated with other Universities of the State of Rajasthan (except constituent law colleges of Universities) shall be run from the present Academic Session 2020-21 only after obtaining affiliation from Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University, Jaipur. Further the aforesaid order dated 22nd July, 2020 of the Government also specifically mandates that the students to be admitted in First Year under graduate or post graduate Law Course from the present Academic Session 2020-21, shall be enrolled with Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University and the students who have already been admitted /enrolled up to the Academic Session 2020-21 in Law Colleges affiliated with other Universities will continue to be the responsibility of those Universities for conducting their examination and also for award of degrees etc.

In view of the above, Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University is going to commence the affiliation process of all Law Colleges of Rajasthan (except constituent law colleges of the Universities) from the present Academic Session 2020-21 very soon.

In view of the above and particularly keeping in view the order dated 22nd July, 2020 issued by the Government of Rajasthan, I am sure that you will

be taking necessary action for immediate implementation of said order in letter and spirit. Consequently, may I request you to kindly ensure that all Law Colleges within the Jurisdiction of your University (except constituent colleges of the University) which were either affiliated with your University upto Academic Session 2019-20 or the Law Colleges which are desirous of seeking affiliation for the Academic Session 2020-21 and onwards, seeking affiliation from Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University, Jaipur for necessary affiliation from the present Academic Session 2020-21.

It will be highly appreciated if you also inform all Law Colleges within the purview of the University in this regard.”

Further, the Registrar of the University also communicated with the Registrars of respective universities for necessary action vide his letters No.F.06II(01)/Academics-II/ALU/2020-21/125-134 dated 21.08.2020 and F.06II(01)/Academics-II/ALU/2020-21/162-171 dated 07.09.2020 and F.06II(01)/Academics-II/ALU/2020-21/276-285 dated 19.09.2020 for necessary action with regard to affiliation of law colleges.

So far no details or documents have been received from any of the universities except the information from Maharaja Ganga Singh University, Bikaner, Kota University, Kota and Pt.Deen Dayal Upadhyay University, Sikar about the constitution of a committee by the university to coordinate with this university.

The University has been very keen to take this forward in all seriousness and shoulder the responsibility of affiliation of these colleges and to ensure smooth transition of the affiliation process the Vice-Chancellor again sent a letter to all the Vice-Chancellors of respective universities requesting them to provide the list of all as such colleges with documents and specific assessment with regard to whether the colleges are fit or unfit (after inspection) for the affiliation for the academic session 2020-21. Information in this regard is yet to be received.

In view of the aforesaid situation and particularly with a view to ensure that affiliation process of law colleges is taken forward and completed for the present academic year 2020-21 with Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University, Jaipur, the following is suggested for consideration and approval:-

- a. All existing law colleges (except constituent colleges) in the State of Rajasthan already affiliated with respective universities situated in the State of Rajasthan during the academic year 2019-20 and which have been found fit by the respective universities for affiliation for the

	<p>academic session 2020-21, shall be deemed to be affiliated with Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University, Jaipur from the present academic session 2020-21 and shall be eligible to admit students in the first year of undergraduate and postgraduate law courses during the present academic year 2020-21.</p> <p>b. All students admitted in first year of undergraduate & postgraduate law courses in law colleges, as mentioned in 'a' above, shall be enrolled only with Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University, Jaipur and will be governed accordingly.</p> <p>c. The aforesaid arrangement and process of affiliation of all existing law colleges in the State of Rajasthan for the present academic year 2020-21 is being done keeping in view the fact that Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law university, Jaipur, a newly established university, is in the transitory phase of establishment and also in view of the extraordinary circumstances prevalent due to Covid-19 pandemic. Therefore, before commencement of the next academic session 2021-22, if considered appropriate, the necessary inspection/verification of the Law colleges will be undertaken, subject to further consideration and approval by the Board.</p>
<p>Agenda No.4</p> <p>Brief facts and background</p>	<p>To consider the adoption/implementation and approval of uniform syllabus for academic programmes to be conducted by various law colleges of the State of Rajasthan affiliated with the University from the academic session 2020-21 onwards.</p> <p>It is important to bring on record that once the colleges are affiliated with this university, conducting the examination of all the law colleges for various programmes will be a huge task for which there is a need to have a uniform syllabus for various programmes of all the law colleges from the academic session 2020-21 onwards.</p> <p>Realizing the importance and immediate need and specially in the absence of academic bodies like CoC, BoS, and Academic Council etc, the Vice-Chancellor constituted the following committee of academicians with a task to suggest the uniform syllabus for the academic programmes commencing from the academic session 2020-21:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 

2.	<p>To consider that the Government may be requested to make required nominations for the Selection Committee of the University.</p>	<p>Section 29(1) of Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University, Jaipur Act, 2019 provides as under:-</p> <p>“29 (1) The Appointment of teachers and officers of the University shall be made in accordance with provision of the Rajasthan Universities, Teachers and Officers (Selection for Appointment) Act, 1974 (Act No.18 of 1974).”</p> <p>The Rajasthan University teachers and officers (Selection for Appointment) Act No.18 of 1974 provides the following Three or, as the case may be, two experts to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor of the University concerned for the selection of the teachers specified at serial numbers 1,2 and 3 in column 1 of the Schedule shall be chosen by him on the advice of a Committee consisting of a member of Rajasthan Public Service Commission to be nominated by the State Government after consultation with the Chairman of the said Commission who will be the Chairman of the Committee, eminent educationist nominated under clause (iii) of sub-section (1) of Section 5 and the members of the Syndicate nominated under clause (iv) of the said sub-section of the said section and said committee shall from out of the panel of names recommended by the Academic Council recommend to the Vice-Chancellor of the University concerned names of at least twelve experts for each Selection Committee which shall be in order of priority.</p> <p>Accordingly, it was resolved that a request may be made to the Government of Rajasthan for nomination of an eminent educationist by the State Government for a period of one year as suggested under clause (iii) of sub- section (1) of section 5 and similarly one nomination also be made by the Government from the BoM of Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University, under clause (iv) of sub- section (1) of section 5 for a period of one year. 3. **To consider the process of Affiliation of all the Law Colleges of Rajasthan except constituent colleges of other universities, for the Academic Session 2020-21.**

Section 4 of Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University, Jaipur Act 2019 provides for the jurisdiction of the University in the following terms:-

“4. Jurisdiction.- (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in any law for the time being in force, the jurisdiction of the University shall extend to whole of the State of Rajasthan and all Law colleges, except constituent colleges of other Universities, shall be affiliated to the Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University, Jaipur in accordance with the Statutes, Ordinances and Regulations made under this Act.


(2) The State Government may, by order in writing-

(a) require any institute, institution or college within the territorial limits of the University to terminate, with effect from such date as may be specified in the order, its association with, or its admission to the privileges of any other University incorporated by law to such extent as may be considered necessary and proper, or

(b) exclude, to such extent as may be considered necessary and proper, from association with, or from admission to the privileges of the University constituted by this Act any institute, institution or college specified in the order which, in the opinion of the State Government, is required to be self-governing or to be associated with or admitted to the privileges of, any other University or body.

(3) The State Government may, in consultation with the University, by notification published in the Official Gazette, enumerate any Government College situated in the jurisdiction of the University to be a constituent college of the University. All the movable and immovable properties of such colleges shall then vest in the University and the officers, teachers and employees of such colleges, after being found suitable through screening and on fulfilling such terms and conditions as may be laid down in the notification, shall be deemed to be the officers, teachers or, as the case may be, employees of the University.”

Accordingly, the Secretary, Higher Education, Government of Rajasthan issued an office order dated 22.07.2020 under Section 4(1) & (2) of the aforesaid Act, whereby it was ordered that all Law colleges situated in the State, except constituent colleges of other universities, shall be run with the affiliation of Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University, Jaipur. It was also ordered that students





taking admission in the first year of Undergraduate & Postgraduate Law courses (2020-21) shall be enrolled with Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University, Jaipur

Subsequently, the Vice-Chancellor of Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University vide his letter dated 27.07.2020 informed and requested the Vice-Chancellors of all universities situated in the State of Rajasthan for necessary action in the matter.

The Registrar of the University also communicated with the Registrars of respective universities for necessary action vide his letters No.F.06II(01)/Academics-II/ALU/2020-21/125-134 dated 21.08.2020 and F.06II(01)/Academics-II/ALU/2020-21/162-171 dated 07.09.2020 and F.06II(01)/Academics-II/ALU/2020-21/276-285 dated 19.09.2020 for necessary action with regard to affiliation of law colleges.

The Vice-Chancellor again on 15th October, 2020 sent a letter to all the Vice-Chancellors of respective universities requesting them to provide the list of all such colleges with documents and specific assessment with regard to whether the colleges are fit or unfit (after inspection) for the affiliation for the academic session 2020-21. Information in this regard is yet to be received from the respective Universities.

The BoM, considering the extraordinary circumstances prevalent due to Covid-19 pandemic and particularly with a view to ensure that affiliation process of law colleges is taken forward and completed for the present academic year 2020-21 in a smooth manner with Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University, Jaipur, resolved the following :

- a. All existing law colleges (except constituent colleges of other universities) in the State of Rajasthan which have been found fit by the respective universities for affiliation for the academic session 2020-21, shall be considered Deemed to be Affiliated with Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University, Jaipur for the present academic session 2020-21 upon receipt of the relevant documents from the respective Universities, and accordingly all such colleges shall be eligible to admit students in the first year of undergraduate and postgraduate law courses during the present academic year 2020-21.

b. All students admitted in first year of undergraduate & postgraduate law courses in all such law colleges, as mentioned in 'a' above, shall be enrolled only with Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Law University, Jaipur and will be governed accordingly.

c. For affiliation of law colleges of the state for the academic session 2021-22, the university may undertake the necessary process and procedure.

4. To consider the adoption/implementation and approval of uniform syllabus for academic programmes to be conducted by various law colleges of the State of Rajasthan affiliated with the University from the academic session 2020-21 onwards.

Realizing the importance and immediate need and specially in the absence of academic bodies like CoC, BoS, and Academic Council etc, the Vice-Chancellor constituted the following committee of academicians with a task to suggest the uniform syllabus for the academic programmes commencing from the academic session 2020-21:

The Committee after extensive deliberations and due considerations to all the necessary aspects, and keeping in view the syllabus of various law universities and their latest curriculum formulated the guidelines for admissions and syllabus for the following Law Courses for the academic session 2020-21.

Undergraduate :

- (i) **B.A.LL.B. (Five years), (Integrated course) (Semester Scheme)(Bi-Semester)**
- (ii) **LL.B. (Three Years Course), (Annual Scheme)**

Postgraduate:

- (iii) **LL.M. (Two Years Course), (Annual Scheme)**

Diploma :

- (iv) **One year Diploma in Labour Laws (Annual Scheme)**
- (v) **One year Diploma in Forensic Science (Annual Scheme)**
- (vi) **One year Diploma in Criminology (Annual Scheme)**

The BoM ratified the decision of the Vice-Chancellor of the constitution of the Committee of the academicians and considered the guidelines for admissions and syllabus formulated by the said committee and resolved as under :

- 1. The Guidelines for the admissions and syllabus formulated by the Committee for the First Year is approved and the same may be implemented from the academic session 2020-21 itself in all the Law Colleges of Rajasthan except constituent colleges of other universities.**
- 2. The Committee mentioned herein may continue till the entire syllabus for remaining period of the respective courses is completed. For this purpose a Sub-Committee of the main Committee is constituted, comprising the following:**
