## **OFFICE ORDER**

The following decisions have been taken in the academic interest of all concerned:

- Students of First year LLB (Three-year programme) need to be provisionally placed in the Second year of the programme with effect 2<sup>nd</sup> August, 2021. Their classes for the Second year may commence accordingly. Further the examination of these students for their First year studies will be conducted simultaneously during November – December 2021.
- 2. The examination of LLM (First year) and final examinations of various PG Diploma courses of the students admitted in the affiliated law colleges will commence from 25<sup>th</sup> August 2021 and will be completed before 10<sup>th</sup> September, 2021. The result will be declared by 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2021 itself.
- 3. The admission process for BA LLB (Five years programme), LLB (Three years programme), LLM (Two years programme) and PG Diploma courses for the session 2021-22 will be started only after the affiliation for the session 2021-22 is decided and only by such colleges which gets affiliation for the session for the same. No admission will be permitted unless the college is granted affiliation for the session 2021-22. The affiliation process for the session 2021-22 is underway.
- 4. In view of large number of vacant seats in all programmes across all the colleges during the academic session 2020-21, the university decides to consolidate the academic programmes and concentrate on quality. Accordingly, the university decides that no new programme or increase of seats in existing law colleges will be considered during the session 2021-22
- 5. The colleges need to take necessary steps in this regard and also to ensure that the students of respective colleges going to appear in the examination are vaccinated and COVID-19 protocol is strictly observed at all levels. The college should provide information regarding the number of students that appeared in the examination and the number of students that appeared in the examination were vaccinated.

Strict adherence is required.
